2013 in Review

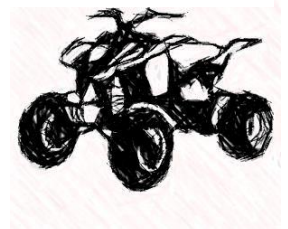
- First year club had a monthly newsletter.
