## 1) UPDATE ON THE C&W TRAIL WASHOUT EAST OF KATLIN ROAD.

This washout will remain for the time being, as the wet and warm weather is creating flood conditions in the area. As soon as the spring melt is over and things dry up, we should see Interfor Corporation working on the repair. We'll keep you posted, with details on our Face Book Page. The Club will also try getting some work done on the C&W Trail from Cascade West to Katlin Road, removing boulders from the trail, adding a kiosk at Cascade facing east before the trestle, and putting additional safety signage in crucial locations.

Good news for our flagship project! We have received a total of \$3,500 in grant money from ATVBC through their Trail Development and Maintenance Grant program.
